The second largest in the nation, the Los Angeles Unified School District enrolls more than 565,000 students in kindergarten through 12th grade. 80% of LAUSD students qualify for free and reduced lunch.

Tutored by Teachers served over 750 students in 10 LAUSD elementary schools during the 2021-2022 school year.

Challenge

Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) experienced unfinished learning due to school closure caused by COVID-19. During the 2021-2022 school year, the district **saw an increased need for accelerated learning** through innovation and disruption across all grade levels.

Solution

LAUSD partnered with Tutored by Teachers (TbT) to implement its High-Dosage Tutoring Virtual Intervention Model in 10 schools in an effort to **improve its students' academic gains in Math and ELA**. Focused on priority standards and in collaboration with school leaders, TbT provided Math and ELA tutoring ranging from 8 to 30 weeks to students in grades K through 6.

Outcomes

Working with Tutored by Teachers, 10 LAUSD schools saw an average of 17% gain in Math standards and 22% gain growth in ELA standards over an 8 to 30-week period.
