The second largest in the nation, the Los Angeles Unified School District enrolls more than 565,000 students in kindergarten through 12th grade. 80% of LAUSD students qualify for free and reduced lunch.

Tutored by Teachers served over 750 students in 10 LAUSD elementary schools during the 2021-2022 school year.

Challenge

Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) experienced unfinished learning due to school closure caused by COVID-19. During the 2021-2022 school year, the district **saw an increased need for accelerated learning** through innovation and disruption across all grade levels.

Solution

LAUSD partnered with Tutored by Teachers (TbT) to implement its High-Dosage Tutoring Virtual Intervention Model in 10 schools in an effort to

improve its students' academic gains in Math and ELA. Focused on priority standards and in collaboration with school leaders, TbT provided Math and ELA tutoring ranging from 8 to 30 weeks to students in grades K through 6.

Outcomes

Working with Tutored by Teachers, 10 LAUSD schools saw an average of 17% gain in Math standards and 22% gain growth in ELA standards over an 8 to 30week period.
